**GROWING BALDOCK  
OUTLINE PLANNING APPLICATION: ADDITIONAL  
INFORMATION**

An outline planning application (ref: 25/02572/OP) for a mixed use extension to Baldock, was submitted to North Herts Council (NHC) in October 2025. Following formal public consultation on the application and ongoing discussions with NHC officers, consultee responses to the application have been received and analysed. In February 2026 NHC issued a formal request for further information in relation to the Environmental Statement (under Regulation 25 of the EIA Regulations 2017) alongside a number of requests for revisions / additional information in relation to the wider application, to address consultee comments.

This package of additional information has been duly prepared and is submitted in order to:

- a) respond to the Regulation 25 Further Information requests (in relation to both the Environmental Statement and the other elements of the outline planning application). Appendix A sets out each element of the requests and how it is responded to within the package of Additional Information;
- b) reflect ongoing discussions with NHC and Hertfordshire County Council (HCC) officers, statutory consultees and stakeholders.

**Additional Information Overview**

The table at Appendix B summarises the contents of this submission and the changes to the outline planning application documentation. In summary, the Additional Information submitted to NHC includes the following:

1. **Updates to the Submitted Application Material** – revised documents and plans to replace that originally submitted, where required;
2. **Environmental Statement (ES) Addendum** – to support the Submitted Environmental Statement; and
3. **New documents to support the Application** – to provide further information with respect to key elements of the application.

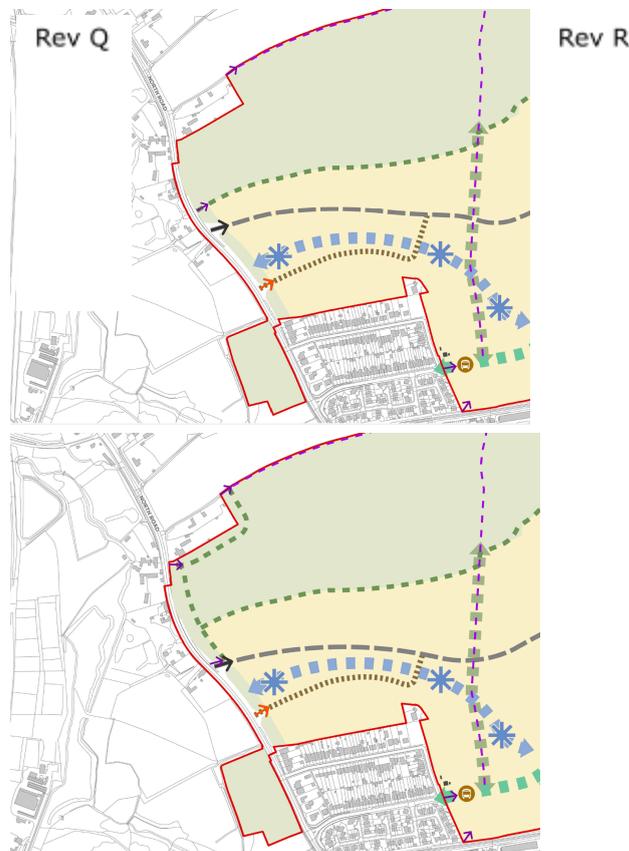
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## Regulation 25 Submission Material

### *Parameter Plan (revised)*

The following minor amendments have been made to the submitted Parameter Plan (UAC092-002 Rev Q) which is now superseded by UAC092-002 Rev R:

- **North Road Gateway and Primary Street Alignment:** the main vehicular junction is located c.25m south to align with the northern edge of the SuDs corridor, with the Primary Street leading from the junction east into the site realigned until it meets the bus only route further east;
- **Additional (further north) pedestrian access into the site from North Road:** including an additional Baldock Greenway spur to Millers Lane, connecting with the new crossing and main gateway junction. This amendment reflects consultation responses received from a variety of consultees and interested parties and seeks to respond to these by improving active travel connectivity and the gateway to Growing Baldock.



### *Development Specification (revised)*

Minor revisions have been made to the Development Specification to include updated terminology around nursery / childcare; an adjustment to care home floorspace, clarity on distance to open spaces and areas where built form will be precluded (land west of North Road) and appending the updated design principles (also contained within the DAS). The Description of Development has also been updated to remove reference to seeking detailed approval for the A505/Royston Road roundabout access scheme into BA1. Instead, this junction will be subject to a reserved matters application in due course, once the exact uses and highway requirements in this location are understood.

### *Access Plans (revised / withdrawn)*

To reflect the above change to the North Road junction location, an updated detailed access plan is provided for North Road (ref: PC7029-ITP-CE-GB-DR-D-0150 P02). In addition, and as explained above, the detailed access plan submitted for the Royston/RoadA505 roundabout (ref: PC7029-ITP-CE-GB-DR-D-0151 P02) is withdrawn from the application.

### *ES Addendum (additional)*

The ES Addendum performs two roles: it responds to the Regulation 25 request for additional information; and it assesses the significant environment effects of the scheme changes set out above. The ES Addendum includes updated introductory chapters and a review of effects for each technical discipline. The majority of chapters conclude that there is no difference in environmental effects as a result of this review. The following chapters include additional or clarified information:

Ecology Addendum – some amendments have been made to respond to comments regarding the significance of effects upon Weston Hills Local Nature Reserve (LNR) and species-specific points raised. This update includes an updated Appendix 11.7 Ecological Mitigation Plan, appended to this Addendum.

Landscape and Visual Assessment Addendum – minor updates are included to Chapter 7 to address feedback in relation to the significance of effects.

Archaeology – following feedback from HCC and Historic England, a Historic Environment Management Plan (HEMP) and a Draft Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI) have been developed and are appended to the ES Addendum.

Socio Economic Addendum – some additional information and clarification is provided regarding the baseline information on matters such as schools, following comments from Hertfordshire Growth and Infrastructure Unit (GIU).

### **Other Consultee Requests**

In addition to the ES Addendum and development parameter changes outlined above, the following revised OPA material is submitted. These documents have been updated to respond to consultee comments and reflect the wider scheme changes.

*Design and Access Statement* – Updates to design principles included within the DAS (and appended to the Development Specification) to clarify the widths of active travel corridors and reflect the amendments to the North Road Gateway.

*Green Infrastructure Strategy* – Updates to reflect changes to the parameter plan including the greenway amendments; scaled sports pitch layouts (indicative) provided as requested by Sport England; and additions to the section on productive strategy (allotments).

*Outline Construction and Environmental Management Plan (OCEMP)* – Minor update to wording to ensure that the proposed construction mitigation aligns with the ES in relation to Bygrave Road Local Wildlife Site.

*Planning Statement* – minor updates to reflect changes to description of development and parameters

### **Transport and Modelling**

Feedback and additional information have been requested by North Herts and Hertfordshire Highway Officers, in addition to Active Travel England and other consultees, including commentary on the potential for economic impacts to the town of Baldock as a result of highway interventions. To ensure a robust assessment is undertaken, this information will be provided holistically as part of a second Regulation 25 submission once the COMET transport modelling update has been completed.

As previously discussed, we are working towards taking the outline to committee in Summer 2026 and would be grateful therefore if material may be issued for consultation so that all issues (save for highways related issues) can be addressed as soon as possible.

<p>North Road Signalised Junctions (new access points for BA1)</p> <p>The pedestrian/cycle route to the north currently terminates with no onward connection. An approach to connect this route to PRow (Bygrave 001) either on existing highway or within the site should be provided to better integrate the facilities.</p> <p>Further information around walking/cycling connectivity southward is needed (see shuttle working comments)</p>	<p>The Parameter Plan (Appendix 2.1) incorporates minor addition to Greenway adjacent to North Road, and proposed changes to the North Road gateway.</p>
<p>Requested a single phasing plan to fully understand the sites build out and infrastructure delivery timeframes. There are various metrics and proposals within the TA which provide helpful information, but this could be improved for better understanding. Flexibility can be enabled through the monitor and manage approach, but the ability to require specific measures through the planning process are required.</p> <p>Whilst certainty over timings for later phases of delivery can be broader, the requirements for the early phases will need to be better understood to enable suitable conditions. Evidence should be provided in such a way that trigger points can be determined based on impacts, not just housing/occupation factors. <p>The LVIA understates the magnitude of the effects in relation to the substantial landscape and visual change within the site and its immediate surroundings, particularly along the northern ridgeline, the open slopes above Baldock and the PRows that traverse the northern edge. These areas will experience notable loss of openness and rural character during construction and the early operational phases.</p>	<p>Addressed in LVIA chapter of ES Addendum</p>

<b>Historic England / HCC Archaeology</b>	
Recommend that the Historic Environment Management Plan be provided with the application. This is in order to outline how important assets would be managed, convey towns history to public.	Historic Environment Management Plan (HMP) and Draft Written Scheme of Investigation (WSI) are appended to the ES Addendum (Appendices 9.6 and 9.7)
<b>NHC Ecology</b>	
Impact of recreational pressure on Weston Hills LNR is underplayed given BA2 proximity	ES Addendum (Chapter 11: Ecology) has been prepared and includes acknowledgement of proximity of BA2 to Weston Hills. However, the residual operational effect remains appropriately assessed as minor adverse at District level and not significant
Clarification requested on species-specific matters.  The Ecological Mitigation Plan (EMP) requires clarification and expansion to address a number of species-specific and habitat management matter	Updated Ecological Mitigation Plan has been prepared and incorporates the requested additional notable species. This can be found at ES Addendum Appendix 11.7.
<b>LLFA</b>	
Requests CV value of 1 and justification for urban creep uplift if less than 10%.	Meeting with LLFA planned to review this issue. If any changes are required, these will be addressed in revised drainage documentation as part of the second Regulation 25 submission.
<b>HCC GIU</b>	
Adult care – comments regarding terminology and land allocated for care home.  Comments on existing baseline (school places etc)	The Development Specification has been updated to reflect comments and can be found within ES Addendum Appendix 2.2.  The Socio-Economic and Health chapter in ES Addendum provides minor amendments to address points, where required.
